Focus for 2020 legislative session

- Mental health legislation (specifically improving Baker Act processes)
- Hands free communication while driving
- Increase teacher salaries
- Social Emotional Learning teachers incorporate into their lessons
- Increase safe conditions for students getting to and from school



Also for 2020

- Census we need your help to get ALL families to fill out the 2020 census.
- Census day is April 1 and is used to determine funding for lots of benefits (\$675 billion in local funding for programs such as school lunch, food stamps, new schools, new roads, legislative districts and lots more).
- We will need PTAs to remind families to FILL OUT the CENSUS!



About our Legislature

- In the Florida Legislature there are 40 senators (23 Rs/17Ds) and 120 House members (73 Rs/47 Ds)
- Senators can file unlimited numbers of bills, House members can file 6
- Last year 1,861 bills filed, 195 made it to the governor's desk
- The leadership of the Senate is critical as President of the Senate (Galvano) selects all of the Committee Chairs and they determine which bills will get calendared
