About our Legislature

- In the Florida Legislature there are 40 senators (23 Rs/17Ds) and 120 House members (73 Rs/47 Ds)
- Senators can file unlimited numbers of bills House members can file 6
- Last year 1,861 bills filed, 195 made it to the governor's desk
- The leadership of the Senate is critical as President of the Senate (Galvano) selects all of the Committee Chairs and they determine which bills will get calendared

What was signed into law?

- SB 7030/HB 7093 Implementation of the MSDHS Public Safety Commission. Increases mental health resources and professionals in schools, but expands the Guardian Program to arm teachers (Hillsborough is not opting in)
- SB 7070 /HB 7075 expands charters and creates a new voucher program Family Empowerment Scholarship Program.
- SB 1112/HB 7123 requires future referendum funds to be shared with charter schools
- HB 107 texting while driving is now a primary offense and drivers must be hands free while driving in School and Work Zones
- Appropriations increase of \$75 for per pupil spending



What was not passed?

- Baker Act bill (priority for PTA for 2020)
- Drinking Water in Public Schools
- Native language testing
- Background checks

- At times the reality is that this is quite challenging especially with representatives that clearly do not support public education. We can say that we align ourselves with elected officials that support our goals of improving public education.


